

# MSC General Board Meeting

Call to order 6:32 by Mary Jane Hee

Jerry asked for any feedback regarding VYSL. Pam Barker said that her U14 team's field was double booked and they had no referees.

Scholarship on the budget: There are 2 set aside for U18's (1 boy and 1 girl). The youth must be with the club for 2 years. The scholarship is for \$1000 each.

**YDL:** Will be finished on Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>. They have 100-103 players. David needs a roster to figure out which players are registered with AYSA. Cheryl currently has 90 YDL players registered. YDL is currently selling Gold Canyon Candles. If a child sells \$400, they will get free registration next session. David has accepted a position with the state (vice president of recreation). He will be working with other clubs to set up their YDL programs.

Jim asked that the duty of fields be assigned to someone else next year. It is very time consuming.

There are no fields on Halloween and Thanksgiving.

Tony has a VYSL scheduled on Nov 24<sup>th</sup>. He needs to double check that game. They usually aren't scheduled the weekend of Thanksgiving.

There was a good response with the donations of old uniforms for Kosovar. He is estimating the cost of approx. \$800. Nicole will check into Fed Ex once she receives the size of the boxes from Jim and the weight of each box.

Jim will be taking over one of Brian's team during high school season.

The fields will be closed for 2 weeks during the Holiday Break.
